

Which Option is Right for Me?

We don't play tennis, but our grandchildren will visit for two weeks and want to play.

Option 1: Choose a Seasonal Membership + Family Tennis Fees ($\$225 + \$370 = \$595$)

Option 2: Choose a Seasonal Membership and add Junior Tennis Fee for Each Child ($\$225 + \35 per child per week)

We have a big family but only one adult will play tennis this season.

Choose a Seasonal Membership + Seasonal Tennis Fee for One Adult ($\$225 + \$160 = \$385$)

My husband and I will both play all summer.

Option 1: Choose a Seasonal Membership + Two Adult Individual Tennis Fees ($\$225 + \$160 + \$160 = \545)

Option 2: Choose a Seasonal Membership + Family Tennis Fees ($\$225 + \$370 = \$595$)

We are weekly renters planning to play tennis.

Choose a One Week or Two Week Membership + Family Tennis Fee ($\$60$ per week + $\$105$)

We have a Family Membership + Family Tennis Fee, but family members living in two cottages. Are we all covered?

No. Only family members within a single cottage are covered. Both cottages will require memberships.

We have a Family + Tennis Membership – can our guests play without a guest fee?

No. Only family members in residence are covered. Your guests will need to pay a guest fee.

I'm only playing clinics. Do I need a membership?

No, you can play in clinics by paying a guest fee plus clinic fee. Why not join and enjoy our members-only perks?
